

## Building The Vision Pledge Information

In order to properly allocate your pledges to our Building The Vision campaign, the Cash Management council is asking that all checks and/or weekly cash envelopes be clearly marked with the intent of your donation. In addition to cash or checks, any correspondence indicating the transfer of stock, property, or other assets to Knox, must clearly state the intent of the donation. Copies of these letters should be addressed to Rita Eagleson, Knox Financial Secretary.

Your check, envelope, or correspondence can include the words "Capital Campaign", "Building Fund", "Building Pledge", "Building The Vision", or some other clearly identifying wording. Without noting your intent, we cannot always be sure where to allocate your donation. In fact, we ask that anytime you intend on donating to a specific cause (i.e., Loaves & Fishes, Hesed House, Go & Serve, etc.) that the specific request be noted.

Beginning with the June 2006 quarterly pledge statements, we have added the record of your pledge to the Building The Vision campaign. For your verification, a running total of your donations toward your pledge will be recorded over the next 3-1/2 years. For those that have not pledged, if a donation is made toward the campaign, that donation will also be recorded.
