This is a unique opportunity for you and/or your family to help in rebuilding churches, lives and your spirit in a week-long mission trip to Sisseton, South Dakota in the Sisseton-Wahpeton Indian Reservation. We welcome everyone, whether you come as an individual or as part of a family. You will find a special place for you in this mission endeavor. Members of First Presbyterian Church (Arlington Heights), Knox Presbyterian Church (Naperville) and Pullman Presbyterian Church (Chicago) join together in the work and the fun .

There are activities for all ages:

Pre-School and Elementary – Vacation Bible School along with Native American kids.

Middle/High School – Join the adult work crew or help with Vacation Bible School.

Adults –There are three principal teams: Construction, Vacation Bible School, Food Preparation.

We will be staying in air-conditioned rooms at the Super 8 Motel or Holiday Hotel in Sisseton. The Super 8 offers an indoor pool, hot tub and great breakfast bar. We try to put families and young adults in the Super 8. If you are an early riser, you may wish to eat breakfast at the Mission Center with Pastor Clint. All meals are provided, including, weather permitting, an evening cook-out and swim at one of the area lakes.

We ask for a donation of \$300 per family or \$175 per person (subject to change) to offset the cost of the motel rooms. Extra expenses include the cost associated with driving up and around Sisseton and for those special Dairy Queen Ice Cream treats at the end of the day!

Furthermore, we (I) and behalf of our (my) child/participant if under the age of 21 years, hereby assume all risk of personal injury, sickness, death, damage, and expense as a result of participation in recreation and work activities involved therein.

The undersigned further hereby agrees to hold harmless and indemnify said church, its directors, employees, and agents for any liability sustained by said church as the result of negligent, willful or intentional acts of said participants, including expenses incurred attendant thereto. If the participant has not attained the age of 21 years, we (I) are the parent(s) or legal guardian(s) of this participant, and hereby grant our (my) permission for him (her) to participate fully in said trip, hereby give our (my) permission to take said participant to a doctor or hospital, and hereby authorize medical treatment, including but not in limitation to emergency surgery or medical treatment, and assume the responsibility of all medical bills, if any.

I, _____, realize that for the duration of this Family Go & Serve trip, I am not merely myself, but part of a group which has been given a very mission is to bring Christian love to the native American community of Sisseton.. I understand that the success of Family Go & Serve depends on me and my ability to follow directions and cooperate fully with other adults and leaders. I will follow EVERY rule and guideline given to me by an adult leader. Moreover, I will treat my fellow students, adult leaders, with the utmost courtesy, obeying their instructions THE FIRST TIME. If I have a question, I will contact an adult for clarification immediately. I recognize that I will be called upon to demonstrate flexibility and patience, and I will demonstrate this with my fellow participants.

I understand that our trip to Sisseton is a serious undertaking, that there is no will no tolerance for disruptive and inappropriate behavior. I will be confronted immediately if I engage in such behavior, and it will result in immediate dismissal from the Go & Serve team AT MY OWN EXPENSE. The following is a sample list of behaviors for which I will be sent home immediately. This list is NOT exhaustive:

- Any attempt to "sneak off" or leave the group without express permission, or any violation of specified boundaries.
- Possession of weapons or use of something as a weapon
- Any attempt to deceive an adult leader
- Possession of illegal substances
- Any threatening behavior
- Any behavior that compromises my safety or the safety of others

Disciplinary measures will be administered by Mat Hacker in cooperation with other adult leaders as appropriate to the situation.
