

This year Knox is doing something different as part of *Come to the Water... service, sabbath, sanctify*. We are committing our time and talents to building a new, handicapped accessible cabin at the Presbyterian Camps at Saugatuck. The Go & Serve Mission trip during the week of June 7 - 13 will have three teams concentrating on the new cabin (Rose II). This cabin will meet all ADA requirements. In addition to the focused work week of Go & Serve, we are planning 3 separate work weekends in order to complete the work on the cabin by the end of the summer.

The **first Work Weekend will be May 23 – 26**, Memorial Day weekend. Under the guidance and leadership of Knox member, Doug McCoy, members of both the Saugatuck Facilities Committee & the Go & Serve Steering Committee, volunteers will complete the decking on the foundation as well as build a temporary floor for staging and building walls. This weekend will be open to as many Knox members who want to work since it is also the annual Saugatuck Work Weekend. Every year the camp takes this weekend to get ready for the summer season.

The **second Work Weekend will be July 25 – 27**. We will concentrate on dry walling and siding the cabin. We will need 15 workers.

The **third Work Weekend will be August 8 – 10**. The team of volunteers will install pine paneling, finish work and complete the siding. We will need up to 30 workers.
